INTERMEDIATE PATTERN
NOT FOR BEGINNERS

Materials

🍎 I will measure the amount of yarn needed in skeins, but you may not need the whole amount.

🍎 You may use any yarn you prefer but i used acrylic and would recommend that for the best results.

🍎 This pattern is written is US terms.

🍎 1 skein of bright red yarn

🍎 1 skein of white yarn

🍎 1 skein of bright yellow

🍎 1 skein of beige (skin colour)

🍎 1 skein of turquoise blue

🍎 1 skein of light blue

🍎 1 skein of golden yellow

🍎 2 small safety eyes

🍎 polyester stuffing

🍎 I use a size 3.5mm hook

🍎 a small sowing needle

🍎 Skissors

And you're ready!

Legs

We are going to work in rounds where you will always CH1 at the beginning then SLST into the CH at the end. This will make seamless colour changes.

Start in **PINK**

1. CH1 into MR, SC5, SLST into first CH. (5)
2. CH1, INC5, SLST (10)
3. CH1, (1SC, INC) x5 SLST (15)
4. CH1, (1SC, DEC) x5 SLST (10)
5. CH1, SC 10 around, SLST connecting the next colour.

Change to **BEIGE**

Cut the pink with a long tail, then tie with the beige tail to secure. Tuck into the leg. You can begin stuffing here also and keep stuffing as you go. You want it to be firm so she can stand up to pack in the stuffing tightly.

6. CH1, BLO SC 10 around, SLST (10)
7. CH1, SC 10 around x14, SLST connecting next colour in final round (10)

Change to **LIGHT BLUE**

8. CH1, SC 10 around, SLST x2 (10)

Close off first leg. For your second leg when doing your last SLST switch colours to **TURQUOISE BLUE** Then leave loop pulled up on the hook.

We will now be joining the legs together by 2 SC.

Refer to images for below.

You will be putting your hook through both legs and pulling through the loop you already have then simply SC 2 across the middle, then continue around the legs to make a seamless round again.

Once connected work around both legs BLO, don't forget to slst into first stitch. (18)

Body

Remember to CH1 at the beginning of every row and SLST at the end for a seamless finish.

Once connected:

1. SC around x3 (18)
2. SC, DEC around (12)

Change colours to **BEIGE**

3. BLO SC around (12)
4. SC around x2 (12)

Change colours to **YELLOW**

5. BLO 1SC, INC around (18)
6. SC around x2 (18)
7. 1SC, DEC (12)
8. DEC around (6)

Close off.

DETAILS - REFER TO PHOTO



Image1. This is what your body should look like so far.



Image2 & Image3.

As you can see in image 2 & image 3 I have used surface crochet to add the top part of her dungarees. Attach the yarn just under her armpit where the dark blue stitch is clear from where you BLO earlier.

1. SC 7 across the front loops
2. CH1, TURN, SC across
3. CH 5 at the end and close off.
4. Attach yarn to the opposite side, CH 5 and close off.

You will stitch these into the shoulders so leave a decent tail to do so.

Also add white details for buttons, see image 4 for guidance.

Arms

In **BEIGE**

Stuff as you go.

1. Make 5SC in MR
2. 1SC, INC
3. SC 8, Change to **RED**
4. SC 8, Change to **WHITE**
5. SC 8, Change to **RED**
6. SC 8, Change to **WHITE**
7. SC 8, Change to **RED**
8. SC 8, Change to **BEIGE**
9. BLO SC 8
10. SC 8 x4, Change to **WHITE**
11. FLO SC 8, Change to **YELLOW**
12. BLO SC 8
13. SC 8
14. 4SC Across the top to close off.



Image 4.

Arm Bands

CH 13, SLST into first CH to create a circle.

CH1, HDC around, SLST x2

Close leaving long tail for sewing.

Attach to arms as show in image and you can bunch up the yarn and sew through to make them have 3 humps around to make it look like they are shaped.



Attach arms to body.



Leg Warmers

**CH15, SLST into first stitch
CH1, HDC around, SLST x4
close off leave long tail.
Attach to legs as shown.**



Large Bow

- 1. CH9, 8HDC with 3HDC in last stitch, move along the bottom of your work, 8HDC, with 2HDC in the last stitch. Close off with long tail after SLST.**

REPEAT THE STEPS FROM THE SMALL BOW TO ASSEMBLY.

This bow will go on the hat so save it for later.



BOWS

Small Bow x2

- 1. CH6, 5SC, 2 MORE SC in last stitch (3SC) go along the bottom of your work with 4SC then 2SC in last stitch, SLST.**

**(leave long tail to sew up.
For the bow we will sew the tail so it is in the middle of the bow and then wrap it around tight to create the bow shape. From there you can tie up the loose ends and sew directly into the leg warmer.)**

Jetpack

In **WHITE**

1. 6SC in MR (6)
2. INC x6 (12)
3. SC around x4 (12)
4. DEC x6 (6)

Close off with long tail to sew.

Make 2 - Smaller pieces

1. 5SC in MR
2. 5sc around x4

Close off with tail to sew.

Attach all parts like shown in image.



Head

Stuff as you go.

In **BEIGE**

1. 6SC in MR (6)
2. INC x6 (12)
3. 1SC, INC x6 (18)
4. 2SC, INC x6 (24)
5. 3SC, INC x6 (30)
6. 4SC, INC x6 (36)
7. SC around x7 (36)
8. 4SC, DEC x6 (30)
9. 3SC, DEC x6 (24)
10. 2SC, DEC x6 (18)



Stuff head and see where you want your eyes to sit. I put mine further towards the bottom of the face for that cute look. Make sure they are 7 stitches apart.

1. 1SC, DEC x6 (12)

Close off, leave long tail to sew head onto body.

Hair

In **MUSTARD**

Fringe

1. CH9, HDC 8

2. Turn, CH 1, BLO HDC 8 x6

Close off.

Side Pieces x2

1. Ch15, SC down

Close off.



I like to Attach the fringe and the side pieces first then add the back hair pieces to see how it sits. In this case you will not need to worry too much about bald patches as the majority of her head is covered with her hat.

Back Hair x8

CH 20, DC across, close off.

Attach to back of the head.

Can look rough at the top we are going to cover it with the hat. Also the wispy hair can be tamed at the end.

Leave space where the ears would be for headphones.



Beanie/Hat

in **WHITE**

1. 6SC in MR (6)
2. INC x6 (12)
3. 1SC, INC x6 (18)
4. 2SC, INC x6 (24)
5. 3SC, INC x6 (30)
6. 4SC, INC x6 (36)
7. SC around x7 (36)

Fold end up and stitch together like a beanie.

Refer to image for details.



Cat ears x2

1. 4SC in MR (4)
2. 1SC, INC (6)
3. 2SC, INC (9)
4. SC around x2 (9)

Attach to beanie.

Headphones

In **WHITE**

(SC 6 in MR,

Change to **DARK GREY**

SC 6 around) x2

Instead of closing off, CH25

SLST into second headphone.



Attach to head like in image.

Dont forget to attach the large bow to the right ear.

Embroid a small yellow nose on the top of the hat as shown in the image.

add any final details you want like blush or personalised accents.
